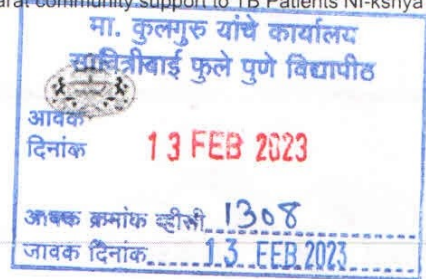

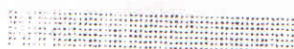
The Central TB Division, MoHFW has initiated a program on "Community Support to TB Patients". The objectives of the initiative are as follows:

- Provide additional patient support to improve treatment outcome of TB patients
- Augment community involvement in meeting India's commitment to end TB by 2025
- Leverage the avenues for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).

The expected outputs of this program are:

- Increased involvement of people and communities in TB Elimination efforts
- Reduction in stigma associated with TB.
- Better nutrition support to TB patients for better treatment outcomes. Specially Marginalized population residing in urban slums can be focused.

Under this initiative, a facilitating mechanism is to be implemented to enable the Elected representatives, non-Governmental organizations, Individuals, Institutions (both public and private), Industry associations, Corporates and partners to support efforts to end TB. The support to TB patients is envisaged through adoption of blocks/urban wards/ or even individual or groups of patients, for effectuating a better response against TB to complement government efforts.

In this regard, the list of patients who have given consent for community support is already available on Nikshay portal and shall be made available by the City TB officer of your corporation.

Subject: National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP) - Ni-kshay 2.0 web-portal

Respected Madam/Sir,

As you are aware, National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme (NTEP) is being implemented throughout the Country under the National Health Mission (NHM) by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India. Under NTEP, all TB patients, notified by public and private sector health facilities/doctors, are provided free diagnostics and treatment and Rs.500/month for nutrition support through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT).

To facilitate enhanced community engagement in achieving TB elimination by 2025, MoHFW has recently launched '**Pradhan Mantri TB Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan (PMTBMBA)**' as a part of NTEP.

To ensure its effective implementation, Ni-kshay 2.0, an exclusive web portal for registration of Ni-kshay Mitra (Donors) and online link-up of such Ni-kshay Mitras with TB patients, has been developed. Interested officers/ Organizations can register themselves as Ni-kshay Mitra and select:

1. The area/number of TB patients they are interested to adopt & support.
2. Type of support (Nutritional /vocational/additional diagnostics),
3. And the duration (minimum duration being six months & maximum being three years).

The higher educational institutions and their affiliated colleges/ institutions are requested to disseminate the information about the programme and encourage the stakeholders to actively support and participate in this initiative by registering themselves as Ni-kshay Mitra at www.communitysupport.nikshay.in For any further information and assistance in this regard, you may kindly approach. MoHFW. The action taken in this regard is to be e-mailed (as per the attached format) to soar.edu@nic.in.
