You are aware that, Mission LiFE has been introduced by Hon'ble Prime Minister Narendra Modi at COP26 in Glasgow on 1 November 2021, as a mass movement for 'mindful and deliberate utilization, instead of mindless and destructive consumption' to protect and preserve the environment.
