in the Department of Physical Education**

φ Qualification	:-	As per UGC rule and NCTE whichever applicable to the post.

- ❖ Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master of Physical Education (M.P.Ed.) from an Indian/Foreign University.
- ❖ Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

Special Notes :-


- ❖ The minimum qualifications required for the post of Assistant Professor shall be as specified by the UGC in its regulations and accepted by State Government time to time.
- ❖ relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Cast / Scheduled Tribe / Other Backward classes (OBC) (Non- Creamy layer) / Differently abled (a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing : (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack , acid- attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf- blindness for the purpose eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace marks procedure.
- ❖ A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- ❖ Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55%, wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.



- ❖ The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D Degree shall not be considered as teaching / research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Regular faculty members up to twenty percent of the total faculty strength (excluding faculty on medical / maternity leave) shall be allowed by their respective institutions to take study leave for pursuing Ph.D Degree.
- ❖ *Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil / Ph.D Programme prior to 11th July, 2009 shall be govern by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for the recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/College/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.
 - a) Ph.D. Degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only.
 - b) Evaluation of Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners.
 - c) Open Ph.D. Viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted.
 - d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a referred journal.
 - e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

*(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/ Pro-Vice-Chancellor/ Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).
- ❖ Candidates belonging to the reserved categories as recognized in the State of Maharashtra shall only be considered under reserved categories. The candidate belonging to the reserved categories form outside the State of Maharashtra will be treated as Open. Those candidates should be apply for open category only.
- ❖ Reservation for women and persons with disabilities, etc., will be as per the norms of Government of Maharashtra.
- ❖ For reserved posts, candidates belonging to the concerned reserved category only should apply.
- φ Candidates are requested to refer Department website (www.unipunedpe.in) from time to time as all information and circulars will be notified on the website by the University. The University will not entertain any inquiry regarding eligibility criteria.
- φ NO correspondence with ineligible candidates will be made by the University.
- φ Candidates called for interview will have to remain present at their own expenses.
- φ The Original Document/s / Certificate/s would be required at the time of interview only.
