

During the tenth Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad to be held during 20– 23 February, 2020, deliberations will take place on a number of important subjects like (i) Can Young India Rise to Zero Hunger, Zero Poverty by 2030? 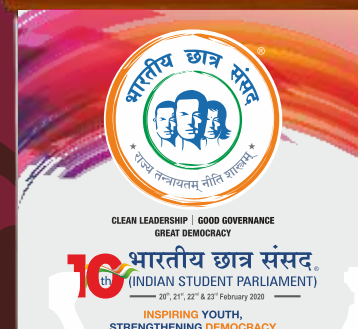
