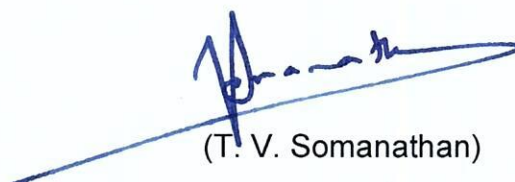

A. Overview

- Constituent Assembly adopted the Constitution of India on 26th November 1949
- Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Notified (in 2015) the 26th day of November as “*Constitution Day*”
- Since then, celebrations are held on 26th November to commemorate adoption of Indian Constitution.
- Many democracies in the world celebrate Constitution Day in [similar fashion.](#)

B. Celebration of Constitution Day during the last 3 Years

2022 (Nodal Ministry : Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs):

- Online portal developed for Reading the Preamble to the Constitution in 23 Languages.
- Online portal for digital quiz with the purpose of “Jan bhagidaari” was inaugurated with facility to generate certificate .

2023 (Nodal Ministry : Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs):

- President of India graced the celebrations in the Supreme Court of India.
- Reading of the Preamble to the Constitution and taking pledge.
- Online Reading of the Preamble and online Quiz Titled- “Loktantra ki Janani” held

2024: (Nodal Ministry : Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs/Partner Ministry: M/o Culture):

- Constitution Day was Celebrated in the Central Hall of Samvidhan Sadan,
- A short film on the glory of the Indian Constitution shown
- Release of Commemorative Coin and Stamp dedicated to 75th Anniversary of adoption of Indian Constitution.
- Sanskrit and Maithili version of Constitution released.
- Release of booklets dedicated to the Art of Indian Constitution.

Activities done by Ministry of Culture in 2024

1. On 26 November 2024 launch programme of Commemoration of 75 years of Adoption of Constitution was held in Samvidhan Sadan. Hon'ble President, Hon'ble Vice President, Hon'ble Prime Minister and other dignitaries were present.
2. A film made by the Ministry of Culture was part of the official programme held in the Samvidhan Sadan (Central Hall of Parliament).
3. Ministry of Culture coordinated the release of a commemorative coin and stamp on 75 years of Adoption of Constitution of India.
4. Ministry of Culture came out with a special book which spotlighted the artists behind the drawings in the original copy of the Constitution and their artworks. This was released by the Hon'ble President, Hon'ble Prime Minister and other dignitaries last year during the programme held in the Samvidhan Sadan (Central Hall of Parliament).

Activities done by Ministry of Culture in 2024 (Contd.)

5. Ministry of Culture contributed with chapters on Art and Calligraphy for 2 books titled “*Making of the Constitution of India: A Glimpse*” and “*Making of the Constitution of India & its Glorious Journey*” highlighting the lesser-known facets about the Constitution of India come into the public domain.
6. Ministry of Culture had also done **overall campaign management and website constitution75.com. Preamble Reading** was the key activity physically and digitally. Total Participation number as recorded on campaign website is more than 1 crore. (1,01,93,569)

Constitution Day Celebrations by Higher Education- 2024

Activities Organized in Central Higher Education Institutions (CHEIs)

- **Advisories Issued:** to AICTE, UGC, and all CHEIs
- **Key Initiatives:**
 - **Read the Preamble:** Provision made on MyGov portal to read the Preamble online and download a certificate.

Encourage citizens- especially students, artists, and young creators- to depict India's legal journey through imagination and storytelling. Participants will design short comics highlighting themes such as the Constitution, access to justice, ADR, women's rights, and digital laws.

- The Department proposes the **release of the Constitution of India in seven additional regional languages: Assamese | Bodo | Kashmiri | Nepali | Malayalam | Marathi | Telugu**
- This marks the next milestone in India's journey towards **inclusive governance, linguistic empowerment, and people-first constitutional awareness**. Each translation represents a bridge - between *Bharat's linguistic heritage* and *its shared democratic ideals*.

- Encourage members to share how the Constitution affects their lives

9. Ministry of Youth Affairs

To facilitate broad participation by engaging ministries, departments, institutions, and youth networks through digital and field-based activities

1. A national-level **digital campaign** to be conducted through the **My Bharat Portal** to mark the celebration of Constitution Day.
2. A **dedicated Mega Event** will also be created on the portal, where ministries, departments , knowledge institutions can collaborate on organizing various volunteering activities enabling MY Bharat volunteers and organizations to upload action photographs from field activities and creating a public digital library showcasing nationwide participation and engagement. This will include Quiz competition, Essay competition, Mega Event and promotion and outreach

9. Ministry of Youth Affairs (Contd..)

Field-based Engagements:

1. **Pledge events:** Pledge-taking ceremonies at government offices, educational institutions, youth clubs, and NSS offices across the country to commemorate Constitution Day. Photographs will be uploaded to the Mega Event section of the My Bharat Platform for nationwide visibility.
2. **Seminars, Debates and Interactive Sessions:** Educational institutions, youth clubs, and training centres to be encouraged to organize short seminars, debates and interactive sessions (30–60 minutes) on Constitution-related themes to enhance constitutional literacy and civic awareness among young participants. Guest speakers and practitioners from public service or legal fields can be invited to share their insights and experiences. Photographs and short video clips from these events can be uploaded to the Constitution Day Mega Event to document participation and outreach.

9. Ministry of Youth Affairs (Contd..)

Field-based Engagements:

3. Community and Creative Activities: - Community based initiatives such as Awareness Rallies promoting constitutional values, carrying placards and distributing flyers with QR codes linking to the My Bharat quiz and essay competitions.

Drawing and Poster Competitions may also be organized to creatively depict themes like Equality, Justice for All, and Unity in Diversity, providing youth a platform to express their understanding of constitutional ideals. Selected entries will be showcased under the Constitution Day Mega Event for wider recognition.
