

1. In reference to the Government of India/ Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Directorate of NSS, New Delhi letter F.No. P. - 32-1/NSS/DTE/2023/134-150 dated 09 Feb 2024 (copy attached for reference)

In the Pan India Campaign starting from 10th Feb 2024, in 99 districts of 12 states are undergoing MDA.
3. In this regard, following are requested:-
 - (a) NSS volunteers and POs may be directed to actively engage in conducting awareness activities on Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) and MDA within their neighbourhood, with a particular emphasis on urban areas and actively engaging in participating in vector control measures and promote awareness about sanitation in the village camps.
 - (b) NSS Volunteers and POs may take up the responsibility of motivating and mobilizing school/ college staff and students within their institution to consume anti-filarial drugs as part of the Mass Drug Administration (MDA) program.
 - (c) The District Coordinators and Area Coordinators may be sensitized to engage NSS Volunteers in order to support the MDA program and disseminate advisory information through a virtual meeting.
4. All program coordinators are also requested to extend all possible support to Officers of Health & Family Welfare whenever they approach you in this matter.





The undersigned is directed to refer to D.O. letter dated 25.01.2024 received from National Centre for Vector Borne Disease Control (NCVBDC), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare mentioning that Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) is a priority disease for Government of the India and is targeted for elimination by 2027. A mission mode pan India MDA will be conducted twice a year on 10th February and 10th August along with National Deworming Day (NDD). In the Pan India Campaign starting from 10th February 2024, in 99 districts of 12 states are undergoing MDA. The list of MDA states and districts is enclosed.

2. In this regard, NSS and NYKS are directed to take following necessary actions :
 - i. NSS and NYKS volunteers may be directed to actively engage in conducting awareness activities on Lymphatic Filariasis (LF) and MDA within their neighbourhood, with a particular emphasis on urban areas and actively engaging in participating in vector control measures and promote awareness about sanitation in the village camps.
 - ii. NSS and NYKS organizations may take up the responsibility of motivating and mobilizing staff and students within their institution to consume anti-filarial drugs as part of the Mass Drug Administration (MDA) program.
 - iii. The State and Rural Nodal Officers be sensitized to engage NSS/NYKS volunteers in order to support the MDA program and disseminate advisory information through a virtual meeting.

Lymphatic filariasis (LF) known as elephantiasis (Haatipaon), is a serious debilitating disease transmitted through the bite of Culex mosquitos which breeds in dirty/polluted water. Infection is usually acquired in childhood causing damage to the lymphatic system. Visible manifestations of the disease, lymphoedema, and scrotal swelling occur later in life and can lead to permanent disability. India alone accounts for approximately 55 % of the global burden and the disease is endemic in 20 States/UTs of India. Approximately 740 million population in 336 districts of these states/UTs are at risk of LF.

LF is a priority disease for Government of the India and is targeted for elimination by 2027. As a vital Strategy, Mass Drug Administration (MDA) will be conducted in a mission mode twice a year on 10th February and 10th August along with National Deworming Day (NDD). The 2024 Phase-1 MDA Campaign is scheduled from 10th February 2024 in 99 districts of twelve states: Assam, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Odisha, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, and Gujrat. **(Annexure 1)**.

The strategy demands synergy of efforts by all the departments and culminates into a "Jan Andolan" for improved compliance of MDA. The roles and responsibilities envisaged for various departments are attached **(Annexure2)**.

The support of the Ministry of Youth, and NSS is pivotal for the successful implementation of the February 2024 MDA and you may kindly issue an advisory to all states and conduct a virtual sensitization with the state NSS & Other officials for the Ministry of Youth to disseminate the discussion points of the NITI Aayog Intersectoral Convergence meeting and passing on the key roles and responsibilities to support the February 2024 MDA campaign.

We solicit your support at the district and sub-district levels for making the upcoming 10th February 2024 MDA a great success.

I am sure, together we will eliminate Lymphatic Filariasis from our country by 2027.
