# **Concept Note: Viksit Bharat Yuva Connect Programme (VBYCP) – Vande Mataram 150**

## **Introduction**

The Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, through MY Bharat National Service Scheme, is organizing the Viksit Bharat Yuva Connect Program (VBYCP), a flagship national initiative aimed at empowering India's youth and connecting them with the nation's developmental roadmap towards Viksit Bharat@2047. The program acts as an effective bridge between the government and young people, especially students from rural, urban and tribal areas, through participatory sessions, dialogues and digital integration with the MY Bharat platform. This initiative reflects the vision of the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, who has continually inspired youth to play a leading role in nation-building and the realization of a self-reliant and developed India (Viksit Bharat) by 2047.

## **Objectives**
