With reference to the subject cited above, The FISU World University Chess Championship 2022 for Men and Women is scheduled to be held at University of Antwerp, Belgium. The Association of Indian Universities (AIU) has entrusted the responsibility to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune to conduct the selection trial of Indian Universities Chess (M&W) teams for the said championship.

In this connection, you are requested to send the eligible Men and Women Chess players of your University to participate in the selection trials of Indian University Chess (Men/Women) teams scheduled from 19<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 at Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

01.	Date of Selection Trial :-	<b>19<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2022</b>
02.	Last Date for Submission of entries :-	<b>Confirm the entries by email to directorsports@unipune.ac.in on or before 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2022</b>
03.	Reporting Date of Players :-	<b>Teams should report on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.</b>
04.	Managers Meeting :-	<b>Managers meeting will be held at 05:00 pm on 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.</b>
05.	The players attending the selection trials should produce the following documents at the time of registration :-	<b>a. Eligibility proforma duly signed by the University Authorities (Two copies) b. Identify Card of the Current Session c. Valid Indian Passport (Original &amp; Xerox Copy) d. Four Passport size Photo</b>

The Eligibility criteria prescribed by the organizing committee of the FISU World University Chess Championship 2022 is attached herewith in Annexure-I. The Tournament is an individual event and will be played under the rules and regulations of the International Chess Federation (FIDE). An amount of ₹ 1,500/- (One Thousand Five Hundred Only) University per player towards Participation Fees, ₹ 300/- (Three Hundred only) per player per day Lodging charges and Refundable ₹ 2,000/- (Two Thousand only) per team as deposit amount should be paid at the time of registration.

## Annexure-I

### **Sports Specific Eligibility of Players/Teams for participation in Selection Trails of the Indian Universities Chess Team (Men & Women).**

1. All players from top 3 ranking teams in AIU Inter-University Chess Tournament 2021-22 held at SRM University Chennai in both Men and Women's categories.

OR

2. The Players with FIDE Rating above 2400 in Men and 2250 in Women category.

OR

3. Players who were top 8 (eight) in Senior or Junior National of last year (from 1st Jan 2021 onward).

OR

4. An International player who has represented India in Senior or Junior categories since last 3 (three) years (from 1st Jan 2019 onward).

5. The decision of the selection committee will be final and binding.

6. Players who have extraordinary international sports credentials or Top Scores / Results In Indian National Trails of Concerned Sports are not covered under the above-mentioned categories may be considered for selection trials by the selection committee after duly scrutinizing their sports credentials with prior approval from the AIU.

7. Only the Athletes who satisfy the following conditions may take part in the FISU World University Championship.

- a) Be a National of the Country he/she represents;
- b) Be at least 18 & no older than 25 years of age on the 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year of the event for 2022; Athletes must be born between the 01/01/1997 and the 31/12/2004
