

Rephrasing/ Modifications of Rules of 2015 Pattern [B.Arch.] Syllabus

1. The Sessional Viva Voce (SV) Marking Scheme is separated out in the syllabus structure as sessional and oral. **It is actually one head SV**. The marks entered in the Mark sheet shall be the total of Sessional and Oral Marks.
2. To bring in clarity following modifications in the rules are done.
