CC151_1 NCC (Theory & Practice) – I

(General, Foot Drills and Commands)

For Semester II only Credits: 2, Marks: 50 Total hours: 60 hours

(Note: These Co-Curricular Courses related to National Cadet Course are only for the NCC Cadets. These courses require regular attendance, parade, discipline and participation in various camps. For the students who are not the NCC cadets courses on similar line would be developed in the future.)

Course Objectives:

1. To acquaint cadets with the aims and objectives of NCC.
2. To familiarize cadets with their Duties, NCC Motto, NCC Song etc.
3. To educate cadets about types of camps and basics for their conduct.
4. To inculcate a sense of discipline, improve bearing, smartness, turnout and to develop the quality of immediate and implicit obedience of orders.

Course Outcome:

After completing this course, the cadet shall be able to:

1. Develop discipline, good bearing and be obedient.
2. Understand their duties and responsibilities.
3. Contribute in team work.

COURSE CONTENT

- **NCC General (Theory) (1 Credit)**

1. Aims and Objectives of NCC, History of NCC, Organization of NCC
2. Duties of NCC Cadets
3. NCC Song, NCC flag and NCC Motto
4. NCC Camps: Types and Conduct

- **Foot Drills and Commands (Practical) (1 Credit)**

1. Basics of Foot Drill E.g. Attention, stand at ease and stand easy.
2. Words of Commands
3. Positions and Commands, Sizing, Forming and dressing etc.
4. Marching, Saluting etc.

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Instructions:

1. Applicability of the Course:

This course shall be applicable only to those students who are formally registered as NCC Cadets in the respective college / institute.

2. Maintenance of Records and Documentation:

All academic and activity-related records, including but not limited to cadet/student registration details, attendance records, activity reports, photographs should be maintained and preserved by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO)/ or Caretaker Officer (CTO) or any other concerned teacher of college or Department/Institution for all exam related purposes.

3. Evaluation and Assessment:

The evaluation and assessment of cadets/students shall be based on active participation, attendance, performance standards, discipline and the quality of reports prepared by cadets/students on NCC activities undertaken during the semester. The assessment and certification of performance shall be carried out solely by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO)/ or Caretaker Officer (CTO) or any other concerned teacher of college or Department/Institution for all exam related purposes, in accordance with University norms and evaluation guidelines.

Internal Assessment Criteria (50 Marks) – Assignments/Reports/Short Quizzes:

The internal assessment of NCC shall be based on the **Assignments/Reports/Short Quizzes** individually prepared/attempted by the cadet/student reflecting participation, learning outcomes, and impact of NCC activities undertaken during the semester.

- **The Assignments/Reports/Short Quizzes shall be Original and individually attempted.**

Mode of Evaluation

- **The Associate NCC Officer (ANO)/ or Caretaker Officer (CTO) or any other concerned teacher of college or Department/Institution for all exam related purposes shall conduct and evaluate from the above-mentioned Internal Assessment Criteria and award marks.**
 - The assessment shall be **internal** and based on **continuous participation**
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
