Module 1 – Traffic Rules & Signs (6 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Video lessons (road signs, speed, pedestrian safety)
 - 1 hr – Webinar: “*Why Rules Save Lives*” (Traffic Police official)
 - 1 hr – Case studies (Pune accidents, PDF + discussion)
 - 2 hrs – Seminar + Quiz
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Module 2 – Licence & Legal Awareness (5 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Video lessons (Licence process, penalties, insurance, PUC)
 - 1 hr – Mock RTO test (via LMS, interactive quiz)
 - 1 hr – Webinar: “*Legal rights & responsibilities of drivers*” (RTO official)
 - 1 hr – Seminar Q&A
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Module 3 – Helmets, Safety Gear & First Aid (8 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Demo videos (Helmet, ISI mark, seatbelts, reflective jackets)
 - 2 hrs – Seminar (hands-on demos in college)
 - 2 hrs – Practical mock drill (accident response, CPR intro)
 - 1 hr – Webinar: “*Golden Hour & First Aid Awareness*” (doctor/NGO)
 - 1 hr – Quiz & safety gear checklist
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Module 4 – Balancing, Vehicle Maintenance & Eco-Driving (7 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Video tutorials (daily checks, fuel efficiency, eco-driving)
 - 2 hrs – Practical balancing drills (two-wheeler, supervised)
 - 1 hr – Seminar (four-wheeler maintenance basics)
 - 1 hr – Webinar: “*Smart Driving = Safe Driving*”
 - 1 hr – Quiz
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Module 5 – Pollution Control & Green Mobility (5 Hours)

- 1 hr – Video: PUC importance, horn & silencer issues
 - 1 hr – Seminar: *Green Mobility* (EV awareness, eco-driving)
 - 1 hr – Webinar with MPCB expert
 - 1 hr – Activity: On-campus PUC & anti-honking drive
 - 1 hr – Quiz
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Module 6 – New-Age Driver Training (7 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Simulator-based training (or digital driving modules)
 - 2 hrs – Webinar: “*EVs & Future of Mobility*”
 - 1 hr – Telematics/navigation tools (app-based learning)
 - 1 hr – Seminar Q&A
 - 1 hr – Quiz
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Module 7 – Driving Behaviour & Road Safety (7 Hours)

- 2 hrs – Video: behaviour risks (speeding, distraction, substance)
 - 1 hr – Webinar: “*Psychology of Safe Driving*” (behavioural expert)
 - 2 hrs – Seminar: road rage, emotional control, respect on roads
 - 1 hr – Group discussion (student role plays)
 - 1 hr – Final quiz & feedback
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Total = 45 Hours

- **Online LMS (Videos, PDFs, Quizzes):** ~18 hrs
 - **Webinars (Experts):** ~9 hrs
 - **Seminars (Classroom/College):** ~10 hrs
 - **Practical Demos & Drills:** ~8 hrs
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Expected Outcomes (Overall)

- **Increased helmet and seatbelt use** among youth, with at least **25% rise in compliance** reported during random college/community surveys.
- **Improved first-aid readiness:** students trained in **Golden Hour response** (CPR basics, bleeding control, shifting patients safely, and emergency helpline usage).

- **Higher compliance with traffic rules** (stopping at signals, lane discipline, zebra crossings) through role-play and case-based learning.
 - **Reduction in risky behaviours**, including:
 - Lower incidence of **drunk/drug-influenced driving**.
 - Reduced **mobile phone use while driving/riding**.
 - Decrease in **over speeding and rash driving** cases among trained youth.
 - **Eco-friendly driving habits adopted**: regular PUC checks, reduced honking, efficient fuel usage, and increased EV awareness.
 - Increased **respect for pedestrians and vulnerable road users**, reflected in safer behaviour around zebra crossings and school zones.
 - Contribution to long-term reduction in **road fatalities and accidents in Pune**, in alignment with national and state road safety missions.
