❖ **Course Objective**

❖ **Guidelines:**

- Students should work in a team of maximum 2-4 students.
- One Faculty mentor to be assigned for each students who will monitor weekly activities conducted under CEP
- College can identify NGOs which are working on Community Engagement Project.
- Students can choose a project from the list of projects conducted by NGO or identify own CEP with the help of faculty mentor.
- The student group will work independently throughout the project work including problem identification, information searching, literature study, design and analysis, implementation, testing, and the final reporting.
- Faculty mentor must conduct project presentations (minimum 4) to monitor the progress of the project groups.
- At the end of the project, the group should prepare a report. The report should follow the style in academic journals and books, with clear elements such as: abstract, background, aim, design and implementation, testing, conclusion and full references, Tables and figures should be numbered and referenced to in the report.

❖ **Evaluation guidelines:**

The final project presentation with demonstration will be evaluated by the Faculty Mentor and one external examiner may be from NGO.
